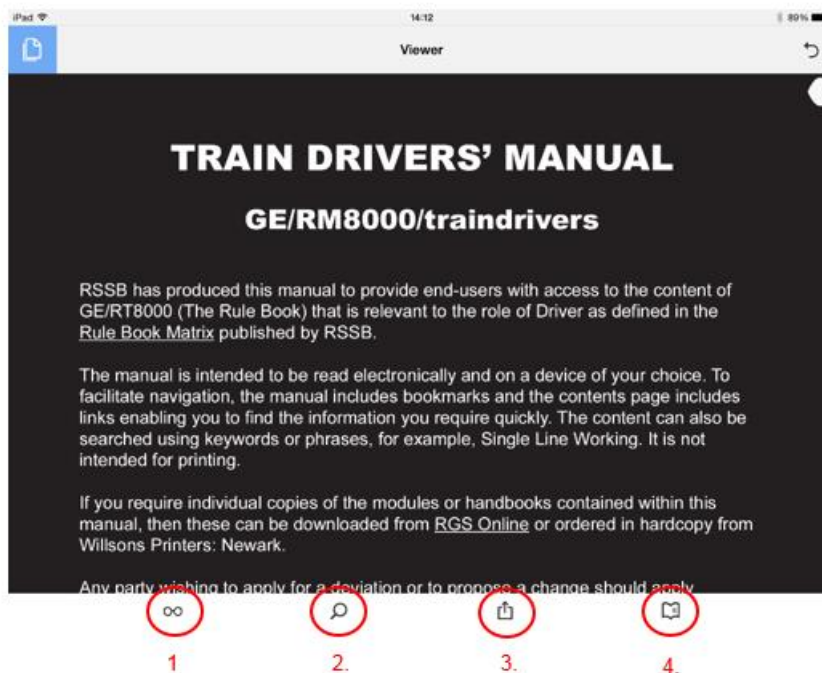


# A Guide to Using the RSSB Rule Book Manuals

The RSSB Rule Book manuals are downloadable from the RSSB website. They are an amalgamation of Rule Book modules and handbooks according to job role. For example, all the relevant Rule Book modules for signallers will be downloadable in one PDF document and all the relevant Rule Book modules for drivers will be downloadable in another PDF document. These manuals cannot be printed but are to be used on a personal computer or mobile device (eg smartphone or tablet). They will be updated every June and December with any relevant Rule Book amendments. This user guide is a step-by-step guide to using the manuals on an iPad. Other devices may look slightly different but will work in the same way.

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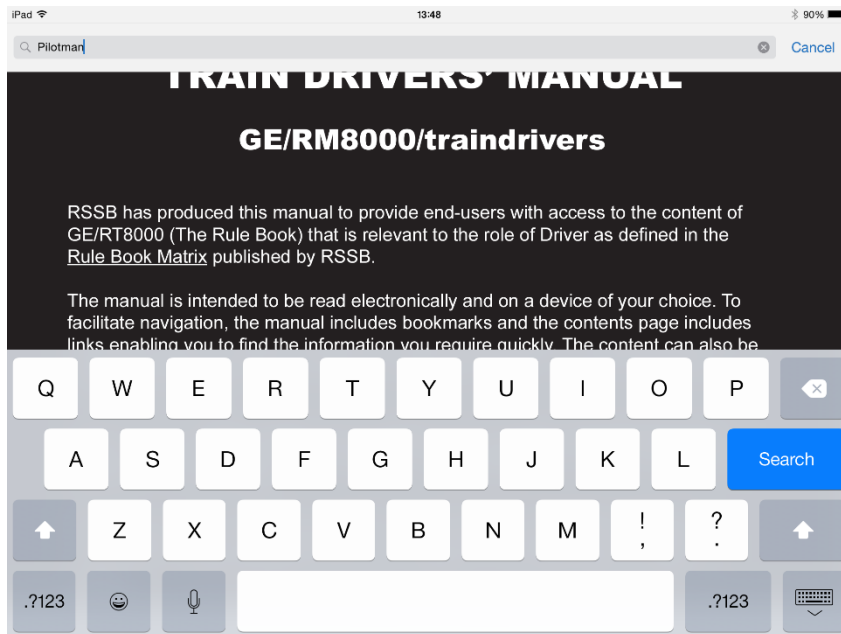

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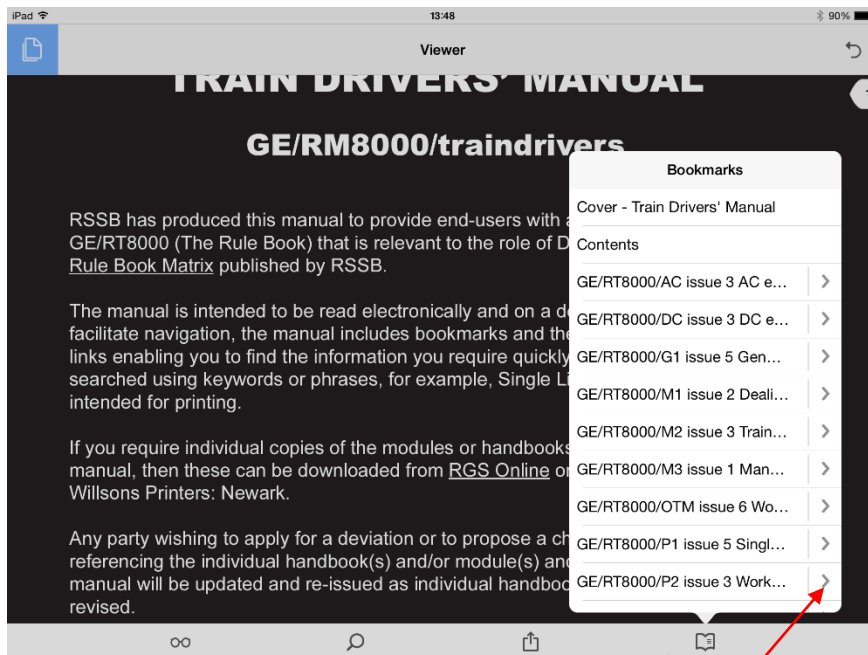
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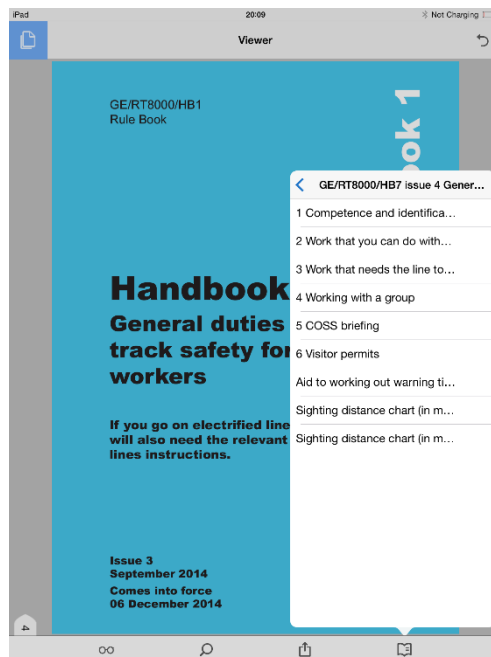
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
